

Dear Friends in Christ,

We have just started to get our feet wet with our Lenten theme: *Wandering Heart*. As we study the faith life of one of Jesus's most famous disciples this season we are also being guided by the lyrics from the hymn "Come Thou Fount". For each step in Peter's journey with Jesus we watch the story of Peter's faith unfold guided by the melody of the hymn, its as if Peter himself wrote the song.

"While the hope of endless glory fills my heart with joy and love, teach me ever to adore thee; may I still thy goodness prove."

Ultimately what I believe we will find in Peter's story is the truth that our God loves imperfect people. That in fact, time and time again that is exactly who God claims and calls.

Peter, I believe, is a heart on his sleeve kind of guy, he follows his heart and does so with passion and gusto. We are learning that faith for Peter isn't a smooth road, but he keeps moving ahead doing his best.

"Oh to grace how great a debtor daily I am constrained to be;
Let thy grace now like a fetter bind my wandering heart to thee."

I have found that this journey with Peter was exactly what I needed at this time in my own faith life. To witness Peter's authentic, imperfect, and heart-forward journey with Jesus has reminded me to look back on the touchstone moments of my own with God. To witness Peter's wandering heart as it is bound to Jesus in those moments that he finds himself sinking or answering his call- is inspiring. Peter is always asking for help, looking for clarity, and open to learning from Jesus.

MARCH SERVICE SUNDAY

Sunday Service Project: SOLE HOPE

Join us during fellowship time on March 3rd as we cut out patterns from jeans and plastic that will be made into shoes to protect children's feet in East Africa.

Sole Hope was founded in 2010 with a mission to address the devastating issue of jigger infestations. More than 1 billion people are affected worldwide by painful parasites. Sole Hope is committed to fighting foot diseases in East Africa by educating communities, providing medical aid, creating jobs, and distributing shoes.





This year our Lenten Wednesday night worship and Sunday morning worship will flow and connect through the theme of *Wandering Heart: figuring out faith with Peter*. On Sunday morning through traditional sermons and new liturgy, we will be introduced to the Gospel text and journey chronologically with Peter through his relationship with Jesus and his faith journey.


